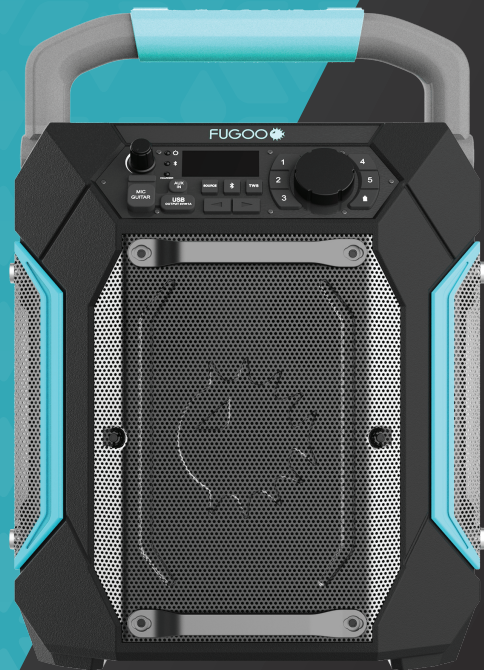

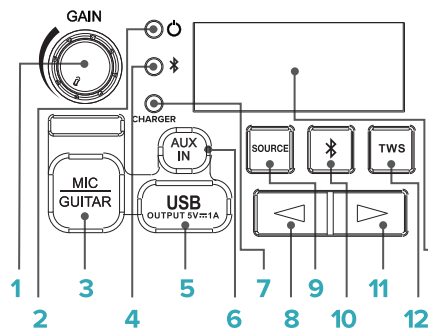

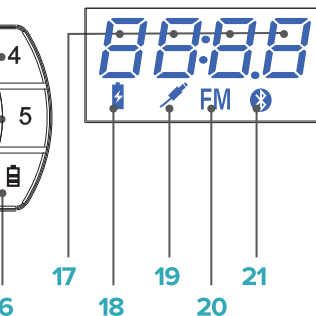

Front Control Panel



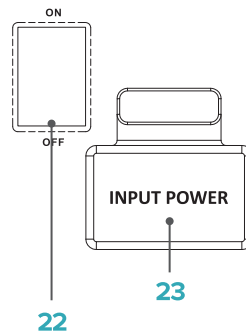
- 1 MIC/GUITAR GAIN knob

Battery & Power

Charging The Unit

IMPORTANT: Before first use, charge for 7 hours.

Connect the POWER CORD into the AC PORT on the back of the unit, then plug the other end of the cord into an AC power outlet.

- The POWER LED will blink while charging.

To Prolong Battery Life:

- If the unit is stored fully charged, re-charge every 3 months; not to exceed 6 month.
- If the unit is stored with no charge, do not exceed 15 days without charging.

Full Charge Achieved:

- 7 hours while powered OFF and 15 hours while powered ON.

Power

Located on the back of the unit.

Turning ON The Unit:

- Flip the POWER SWITCH UP / ON position
- The units LED DISPLAY will read **HI** and will automatically connect to the last audio source selected.

Turning OFF The Unit:

- Flip the POWER SWITCH DOWN / OFF position

Battery Status

Status is ONLY available while the unit is ON.

Battery Level..... Press  button

- The LED Display will show the battery level in increments of 25.
Ex: **b 25** & **Low** when below 25% charged.
- The LED Display **LOW BATTERY** Indicator will turn on when the battery level is below 25%.

USB Power Bank

The USB port is NOT an audio connection.

- When the unit is ON, the 5V 1A USB port will charge an external device using the units internal battery. (Cable not included)

Standby Mode

Enter:

- VOLUME/RADIO dial Hold (3 seconds)
- The LED DISPLAY will read **Stby**; The POWER LED will blink.
- The unit will automatically enter into STANDBY MODE after 15 minutes of inactivity or lack of connection.

Exit:

- Press any control button to wake the unit from.
- The units LED DISPLAY will read **HI** and will automatically connect to the last audio source selected.

Audio

GUITAR/MICROPHONE Input & GAIN knob


Devices plugged into the ¼" input will transmit through all audio sources. (Microphone not included)

GAIN knob:

- Turn it clockwise to increase the output of the device plugged into GUITAR/MICROPHONE input and counter-clockwise to decrease it.

AUX IN

The unit will automatically change to AUX IN mode when a 3.5 mm cable is connected into the input.

- Press the SOURCE button until the LED Display reads **AUX** and the AUX indicator  is lit.

Equalizer PRESETS

These presets are **ONLY** available when the Bluetooth® or AUX IN audio sources are selected.

- Press any NUMBER PRESET button to select a tone setting. The LED Example: The display will read **EQ-1** when the NUMBER PRESET button 1 is selected. See below for tones.

#1 - Flat, #2 - Jazz, #3 - Default, #4 - Guitar, & #5 - Vocal

FM Radio & Radio PRESETS

Selecting the FM Radio Audio Source:

- Press the SOURCE button until the LED Display reads **TUNE** and the FM Radio Indicator **FM** is lit.

Setting FM Radio Frequency:

- Use the ◀ or ▶ button to change the radio frequency. Hold either of the arrow buttons to scan for radio stations.

Setting FM Radio PRESETS Station:

- Save the current radio station to a NUMBER PRESET button by pressing and holding the number until the LED Display confirms it has been saved by reading **P1** when 1 is set, etc.

Select PRESETS Station:




- Recall a saved radio station by pressing one of the NUMBER PRESET buttons while in FM Radio.

Audio Continued

IMPORTANT: WHEN USING BLUETOOTH AND TWS PAIRING.

DON'T have a cable plugged into the **AUX IN** port.
Pair devices within **10 feet (3 meter)**; Max signal range of **33 foot (10 meter)**; Signal disruption/loss may accoure when devices are out of range from each other.


Bluetooth® Pairing

- 1 Select Bluetooth® audio Press  button
 - **BLUETOOTH® LED** Flashes Blue
 - **LED DISPLAY BLUETOOTH® INDICATOR** 
- 2 Enter Pairing Mode Hold  button (3 seconds)
- 3 Turn your audio source device' Bluetooth® ON
select **"FUGOO TRAVELER"**

Disconnect: Press the  button (3 seconds).

TWS Pairing

Wirelessly connect two compatible FUGOO TWS units.

- 1 **Transmitter:** Pair the first unit to a Bluetooth® external audio device source. (see Bluetooth® Pairing)
- 2 **Receiver:** Power ON a second TWS capatible unit.
Set to Bluetooth® audio mode.
DO NOT Bluetooth® pair to the audio device
Disconnect: Hold the  button (3 seconds).

4 Transmitter & Receiver: Hold the TWS button (2 seconds) of the Transmitter and then the Receiver to search for TWS pairing.




BLUETOOTH® LEDS:

TWS Pairing Search:Flashes Blue/Purple
Transmitter: Solid Purple
Receiver: Solid Red

Disconnect: Press the TWS button

Audio Controls

Controls are **ONLY** available in Bluetooth® and TWS audio modes.

Play / Pause Click  button
Next Track Click  button
Previous Track Click  button

VOLUME:

Master Volume Connected Bluetooth® device' volume
Adjusted the volume of the connected units (Transmitter & Receiver) independently from one another.

Unit Volume Turn **VOLUME Dial**

- Clockwise Increase
- Counter-clockwise Decrease

This Limited Warranty is conditioned upon proper use of Product by you, the Purchaser. This Limited Warranty does not apply to store display products and product sold as a "marked down" special, in as is condition, "close outs", "liquidation and clearance sales", "open box", "products missing accessories", or "no fault found".
